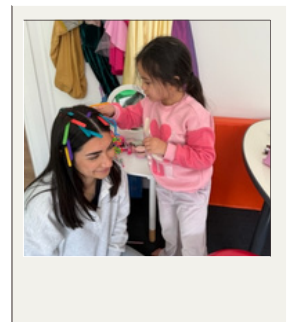


ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS & ALLIED HEALTH ASSISTANT NDIS PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

To help us meet demand for our allied health services, increase therapy affordability and reduce wait times, we offer a partnership program between our allied health professionals and our allied health assistant (AHA).

HOW DOES THIS PROGRAM WORK?

- Initial planning, goal setting and ongoing session programming is completed by our registered therapists.
- Therapy sessions are delivered by experienced and supervised therapy assistants.
- Regular check-ins by our therapists ensures goals are updated as needed.
- If you have questions the AHA is not able to answer, they will bring it back to supervision with the treating therapist and report back to you.
- Any assessments and reports required are completed by the therapists as per professional requirements



WHAT ARE THE FEES?

- Sessions/assessments/reports/letters by the therapists are charged at \$193.99/hr. Reports often take multiple hours. Please ask for a quote prior if required.
- Sessions run by the allied health assistant are charged at \$108.49 per session (75 minutes).
- Resources developed by the allied health assistant are charged at \$86.79 per hour.
- Mandatory non-face-to-face session programming by the therapists is charged at 15 mins/session (invoiced as 1 hour after every 4 sessions at \$193.99/hr).
